



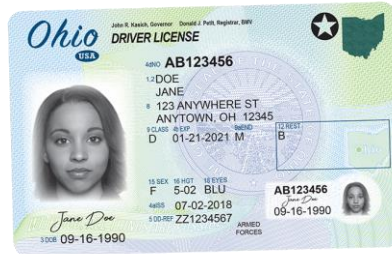

ALERT!

Big changes are coming to your Ohio BMV starting July 2nd! Be sure to educate yourself on what you need to bring before you renew your Ohio license. If you travel by plane, you will need to get a compliant ID by October 1, 2020. If you don't travel by plane you can get a Standard ID.

DL-ID



Some of the new changes are:

- When you apply for a new license, you will leave with a temporary ID
- You will receive your new license by mail within 10 days
- There are now two types of licenses: compliant and standard
- Ohio Driver's Licenses will have a new look (see above picture)

Compliant IDs:

- Meet new federal travel guidelines
- You will be required to bring documents to prove the following:
 - Full legal name
 - Date of Birth
 - Legal U.S. Citizenship
 - Social Security Number
 - Address-two documents required

You can wait until your current license expires unless it expires after October 1, 2020 and you plan to fly.
