ALERT!

I was recently contacted by a woman who received two emails allegedly from Time Warner Cable. The emails claimed that her last month's cable payment was "rejected by [her] credit card" and that her cable was in danger of being deactivated.

Alarmed, she checked her personal records as well as the official Time Warner website to ensure that nothing was owed. Both sources confirmed that her payments were received by the company. It became apparent that the two emails were scams and that the website link in the two emails was fraudulent.

Remember, don't open emails or download attachments from unknown sources. If you receive an email claiming one of your accounts is delinquent, check your personal transaction records as well as company records to confirm that your payments have been received.
