Akron Man Found Guilty of Murder

AKRON, Ohio (Wednesday, July 20, 2016) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that a Summit County jury found Michael Huguley, 36, of Alphada Avenue in Akron, guilty in connection with the stabbing death of the mother of his child.

Jurors found Huguley guilty of the following charges:

- Two Counts of Murder – both special felonies
- Felonious Assault – a felony of the 2nd degree
- Domestic Violence – a misdemeanor of the 1st degree

In June of 2015, Huguley stabbed 31-year-old Jasmine Williams to death in an Akron apartment. Huguley was captured five weeks later by members of the U.S. Marshals Northern Ohio Violent Fugitive Task Force. Huguley and Williams were living together at the time and had a young child together.

Huguley faces life in prison and is scheduled to be sentenced on Thursday, July 21, 2016 at 1:30pm.
