Burglary Arrest

On February 3, 2018, at approximately 8:20 a.m., the Summit County Sheriff's Office received several 911 calls regarding a naked man running in the roadway in Coventry Township. Deputies responded and found the man holding a bloody knife and box cutter. It was determined that the man had attempted to gain entry to a residence by pounding on the door and windows. He was also found to be in possession of methamphetamine. The man was identified as Grant W. Rudd, age 32 of Coventry Township. He was transported to Akron City Hospital by the Coventry Fire Department.

While at the hospital, the man became combative and assaulted the medical staff. Sheriff's Deputies arrested Rudd and transported him to the Summit County Jail. He was charged with Attempted Aggravated Burglary (F-2) and Possession of Drugs – Methamphetamine (F-5). Additional charges are pending the outcome of the investigation.
