**Robbery Arrests in Green**

On March 29, 2017, at approximately 12:50 a.m., the Summit County Sheriff's Office responded to reports of a robbery that occurred at the Circle K located at 3520 Arlington Road in the city of Green. It was reported that a pizza delivery driver stopped at the above location after his shift to purchase some things at the store. A white Ford Fusion occupied by two male suspects pulled in behind the victim. The victim was followed into the store by the two suspects. The victim paid for his purchases and returned to his vehicle. The suspects confronted the victim as he attempted to enter his vehicle. One of the suspects shut the victim's door and reportedly said, "Give me the money so I don't have to pull the hammer down." The victim went back into the store and instructed the cashier to call the Sheriff's Office. Both suspects fled the scene in the Ford Fusion.

Shortly thereafter, the suspects were located at a motel in the city of Green. No weapons were located, but deputies found evidence of the robbery. Subsequently, Ronald Henry Jr., age 23 of Oakwood Village and Wesley R. Hudson, age 23 of Aurora were arrested and charged with Robbery (F-3). They were booked into the Summit County Jail. Further charges are pending the outcome of the investigation.
