2 Arrests in Green

On April 8, 2018, at approximately 6:00 p.m., the Summit County Sheriff's Office received several 911 calls in regards to a large fight at the Dollar Tree located on Arlington Ridge in the City of Green. It was reported that 4-5 males chased another male into the store and they were assaulting the unconscious male. When the deputies arrived, the suspects had fled the scene. The 27 year old male victim was treated and released on scene by the Green Fire Department.

The deputies noticed a vehicle leaving the area at a high rate of speed. The vehicle, which contained 2 occupants, was stopped by deputies. The passenger fled on foot. The driver was identified as Denzel A. Rackley, age 27 of Akron. The passenger was apprehended after a short foot pursuit. The passenger was identified as Dashaun J. Martin, age 26 of Cleveland. Martin had active warrants for Escape and Parole Violation. Inside the vehicle, deputies located two loaded handguns. One of the handguns had been reported stolen.

Rackley and Martin were arrested and charged with Carrying a Concealed Weapon (F-4). They were transported to the Summit County Jail. Additional charges are pending the outcome of the investigation.
