Arrest Made for School Threat

On April 8, 2018, a 17 year old Green resident ordered a marijuana smoking device through an online vendor. On April 10, the 17 year old male sent an email to the company and stated that if he did not receive his "weed smoking apparatus" soon, he was going to his local high school with an AR-15. On April 11, the vendor contacted the Summit County Sheriff's Office in regards to the threat. The Green High School Resource Officer along with the Sheriff's Detective Bureau responded and detained the student. The student was arrested and charged with Telecommunications Harassment (M-1) and Making False Alarms (M-1). He was subsequently transported to the Summit County Juvenile Detention Center.
