PRESS RELEASE Fatal Crash in Green

On Sunday, August 6th, at approximately 5:57 p.m., a three-vehicle crash occurred in the City of Green. The crash resulted in one fatality and one minor injury. A 2017 Suzuki Gladius motorcycle was traveling southbound on South Main Street when a 1999 Ford Escort travelling northbound attempted to make a left turn into 4900 South Main Street. The motorcycle and Escort collided, causing the motorcycle and rider to separate. The rider was ejected from the motorcycle and came to final rest approximately 47 feet south of the point of impact. The motorcycle slid into the northbound lane and into the travel path of a 2013 Hyundai Santa Fe. The Green Fire Department transported the motorcycle operator, a 20 year old New Franklin man to Akron City Hospital with serious injuries. The driver of the Escort, a 22 year old female sustained superficial lacerations and was treated and released on scene. The driver of the Hyundai sustained no injuries. The 20 year old New Franklin man (motorcycle rider) was pronounced dead at Akron City Hospital. The roadway was closed for approximately 2 hours. Speed, alcohol and/or drug use are unknown at this time. The crash remains under investigation.
