Burglary in the City of Green - Update

On August 12, 2020, at approximately 2:40 a.m., the Summit County Sheriff's Office received a 911 call from a residence on Graybill Road in the city of Green. The homeowner reported a female had entered the home and was found in an upstairs room. The female was detained by the homeowner until the Sheriff's Office responded to the residence. The female intruder was originally identified as Emma M. Ryland, age 29 of Akron through information given by the suspect. It was later determined that the suspect's actual identity is Megan S. Ryland, age 30.

All charges against Emma Ryland will be dismissed. Megan Ryland will be charged with Burglary (F-2) along with additional charges for misrepresenting herself to law enforcement officers. She is currently housed in the Summit County Jail.
