Meth Explosion

On August 14, 2020 at approximately 6:00 a.m., the Summit County Sheriff's Office and Coventry Fire Department responded to a residence on South Main Street in Coventry Township for a reported explosion in a garage. The nine occupants of the home were evacuated from the residence. The Coventry Fire Department extinguished a fire in the single-car garage (attached). No injuries were reported at the scene.

After further investigation, it was determined that two of the residents had been manufacturing methamphetamines in the garage. The suspects possessed several chemicals and equipment used to manufacture methamphetamines. In addition, baggies and suspected meth and fentanyl were located on the premises.

The suspects were identified as Jennifer A. Hanam, age 35 of Coventry and Cliff J. Cundiff, age 36 of Coventry. Cundiff and Hanam were charged with Illegal Manufacturing of Drugs (F-1) and Illegal Assembly or Possession of Chemicals for Manufacture of Drugs (F-2). Additional charges are pending the outcome of the investigation.
