Shooting in Green

On August 27, 2020, at approximately 12:15 a.m., the Summit County Sheriff's Office responded to Schneiderman Drive in the City of Green in regards to reports of a shooting. When deputies arrived, they found two males with gunshot wounds. A few minutes later, the Sheriff's Office responded to reports of a man with gunshot wounds on South Main Street, approximately ½ mile from the scene on Schneiderman Drive. It was determined that the man on South Main Street had been shot at the apartment on Schneiderman Drive. All three men were transported to Cleveland Clinic Akron General by the Green Fire Department. One of the men was treated and released from the hospital. The two others are still in the hospital. One is in serious condition and the other has life threatening injuries.

One of the men has been identified as Rayshawn K. Simmons, age 22 of Canton. Simmons was arrested and charged with Possession of Drugs – Cocaine (F-5) and Trafficking in Drugs – Cocaine (F-5). He was booked into the Summit County Jail.

The incident remains under investigation by the Summit County Sheriff's Detective Bureau.
